TITLE :	Curriculum, Attainment and Standards
MEMBERSHIP:	At least four governors plus the headteacher.
QUORUM:	Three members of the committee and the headteacher (or deputy headteacher in the absence of the headteacher)
MEETINGS:	Once a term and otherwise as necessary

TERMS OF REFERENCE:

- To ensure that the school curriculum meets statutory requirements, in-line with the Ofsted framework
- To ensure that on-line learning facilities are in place in the event of partial or whole school closure
- To provide advice, support and guidance to the headteacher and Governing Body on all matters relating to the school curriculum
- To review the school's curriculum policies and make recommendations to the Governing Body as required
- To review the policy for RE, collective worship and sex education and make recommendations where necessary
- To monitor and review information about school standards and reporting to parents according to statutory requirements and ensure this information is reported to the Governing Body
- To monitor and review the progress of pupils at the school in line with national age related expectations
- To monitor the impact of curriculum planning and policies on pupil progress, with particular reference to individual groups.
- To review the SEF (School Self Review) and School Development Plan (SDP) and the major priorities for development at the school and report updates to the Governing Body
- To consider complaints against the curriculum
- To monitor and review the school's curriculum and assessment provision and make recommendations where necessary.

Election of chair

The chair will be elected at the first meeting of each academic year by the committee.

Recording and reporting of meeting

The School Business Manager (SBM) will be the clerk to the committee, and will produce minutes of all meetings to be circulated before the full governing body meeting following the committee meeting.
